

A consensus-based list of medicines suitable for the management of terminal symptoms in community and residential aged care facilities in Australia

Clonazepam liquid (oral drops) ^{1,2}	2.5 mg/mL (0.1 mg/drop)	1 bottle (10 mL)
Clonazepam injection ¹	1 mg/mL	1 box (5 ampoules)
Fentanyl citrate injection ³	100 µg/2 mL	1 box (5 ampoules)
Haloperidol injection ^{1,2}	5 mg/mL	1 box (10 ampoules)
Hydromorphone injection ⁴	2 mg/mL	1 box (5 ampoules)
Hyoscine butylbromide injection ^{2,4}	20 mg/mL	1 box (5 ampoules)
Metoclopramide injection ^{2,4}	10 mg/2 mL	1 box (10 ampoules)
Midazolam injection ²	5 mg/mL	1 box (10 ampoules)
Morphine (sulfate or hydrochloride ²) injection ⁴	10 mg/mL AND 30 mg/mL	1 box (5 ampoules)
